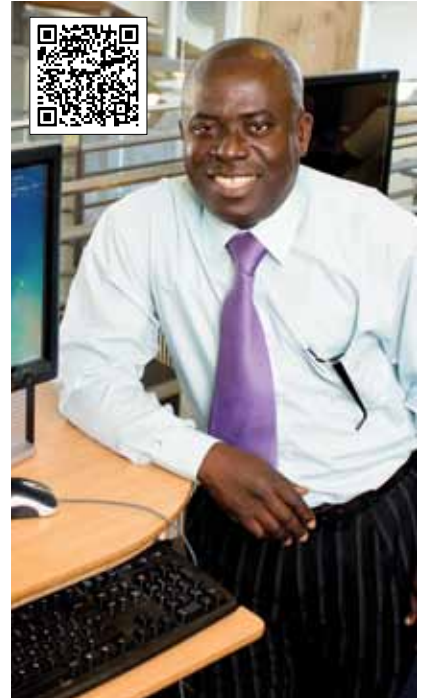



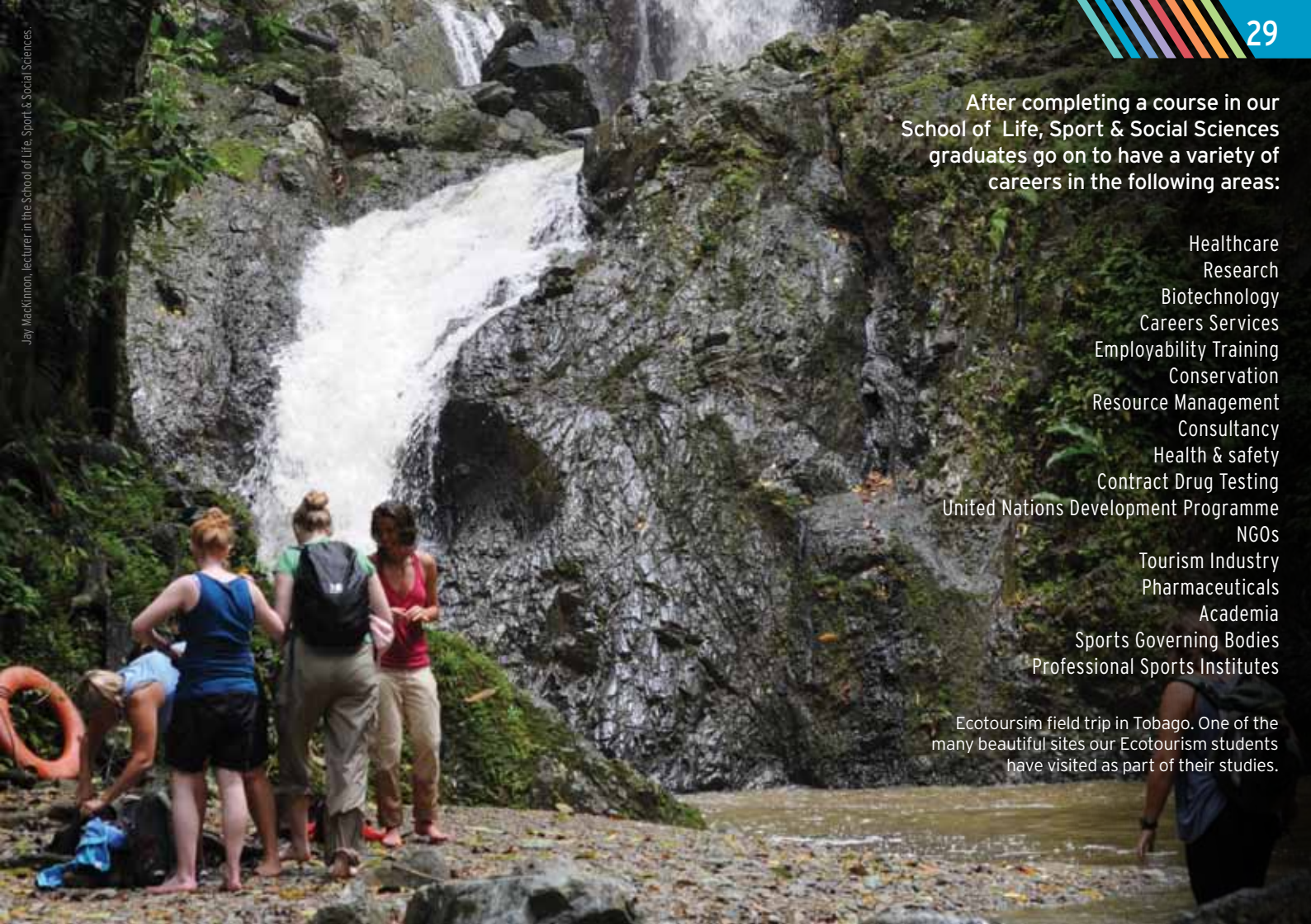

### Visa

There have been a lot of changes to UK immigration policy and it is now compulsory for all students coming to study in the UK for more than six months to obtain Entry Clearance in their own country before coming to the UK. Please ensure that you check the UK Visas website for the latest information [www.ukvisas.gov.uk/en](http://www.ukvisas.gov.uk/en)

### Fees

Fees for undergraduate courses in 2013/14 range from £10,080 to £11,700 and fees for postgraduate courses in 2013/14 range from £10,760 to £13,300. Please note that fees are subject to change and vary from course to course so please check our website for up to date information. [www.napier.ac.uk/international](http://www.napier.ac.uk/international)

For international students (non-EU) we require a prepayment of £3,500 before you can receive an unconditional offer letter if your fees are more than £6,500. If your fees are less than £6,500 we require an advance payment in full.

## Postgraduate students

Starting from 2012/13 all EU postgraduate students can apply to SAAS for a tuition fee loan of up to £3400 for eligible courses. This will be re-payable upon graduating and when earning over an annual UK equivalent salary of £15,000. 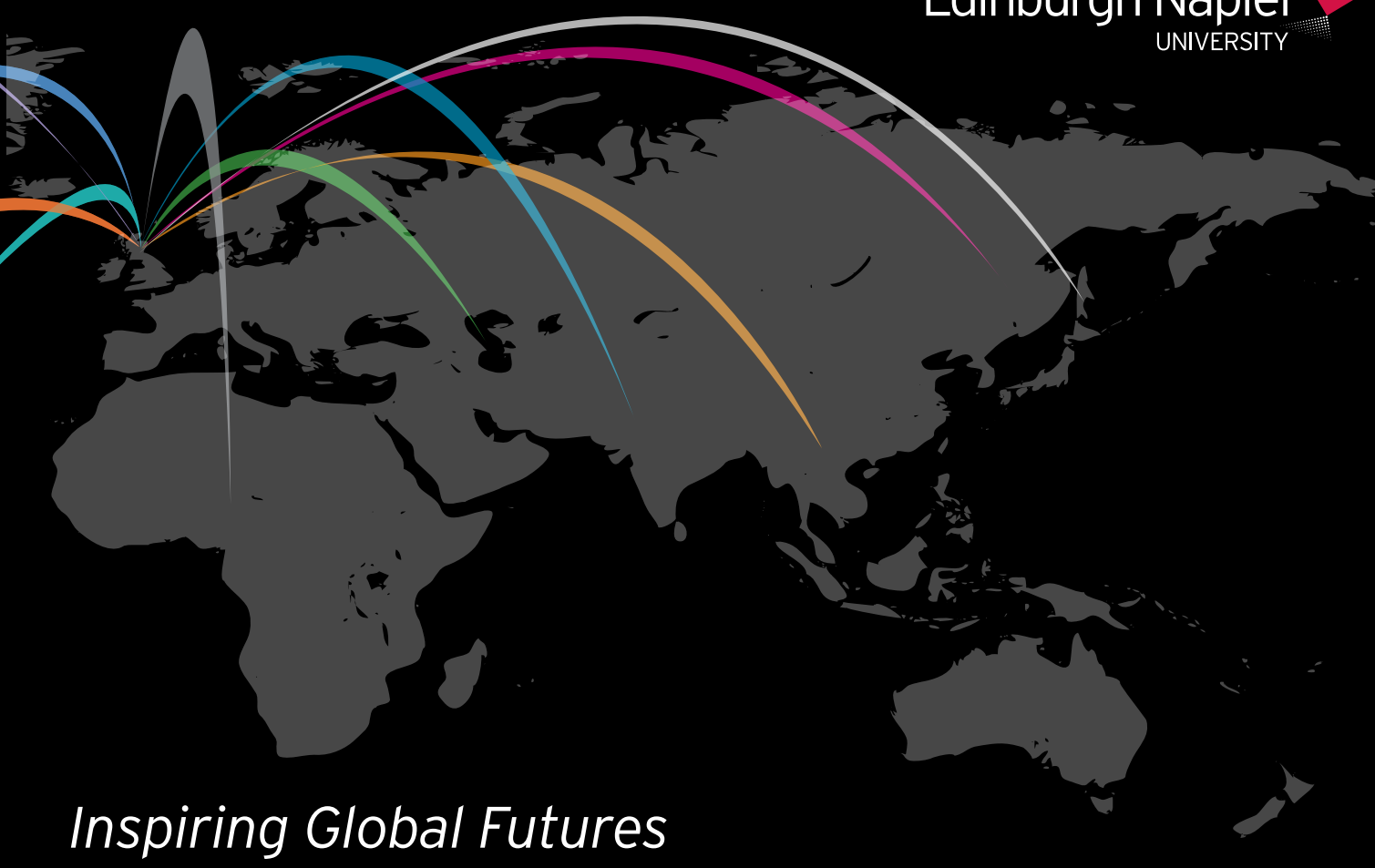

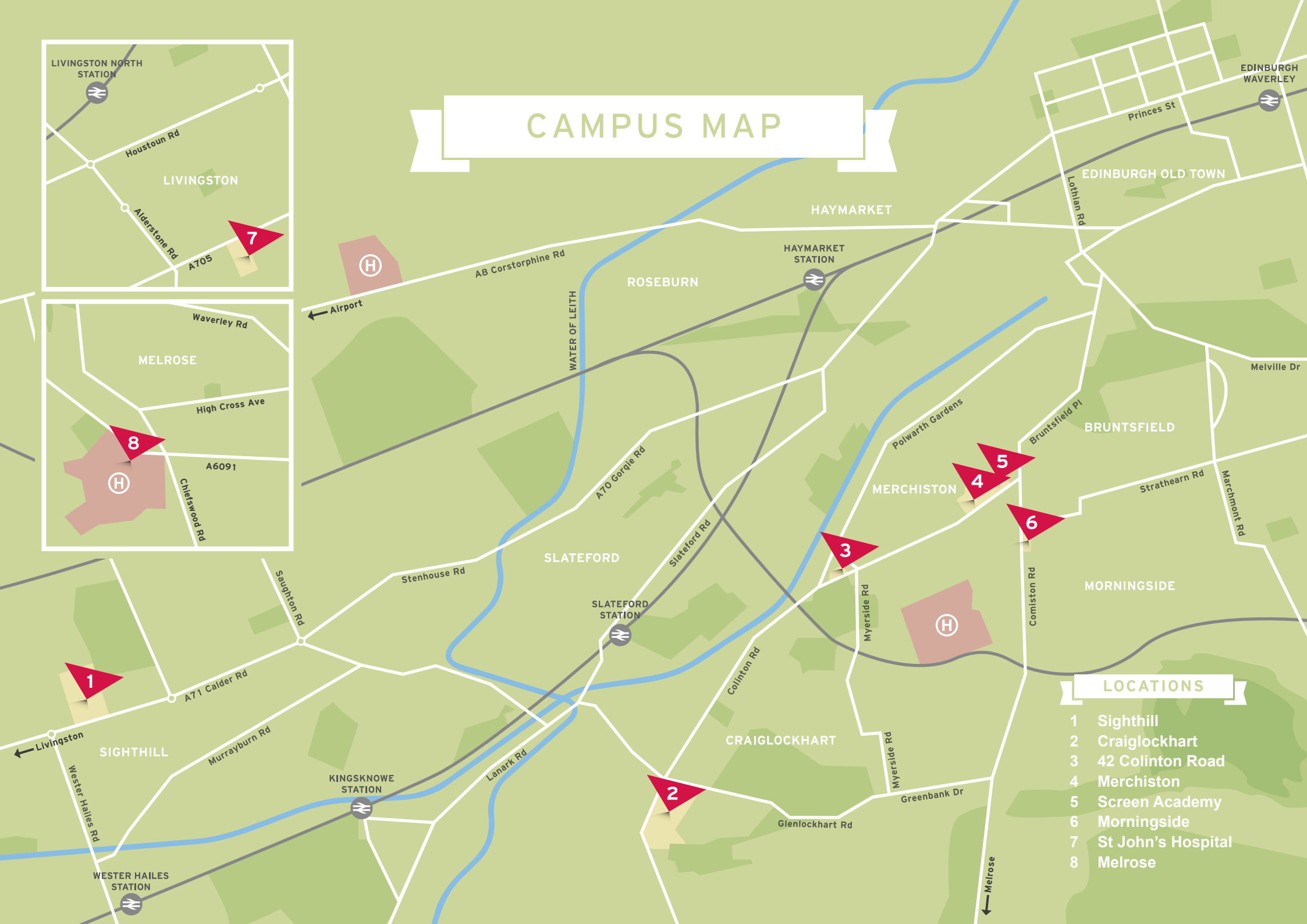

## Support Available

While you're settling into life in Edinburgh, from time to time you might need a little help along the way. There are lots of great resources on campus to help you sort out everything, from legal issues to finding a new flat.

## Visa Immigration

### Do I need a visa to enter the UK?

Non-EU international students will need a passport and the correct entry clearance to study in the UK at Edinburgh Napier. European Economic Area (EEA) students have the right to free movement and residence in the UK and do not require a visa, however must show a passport or ID card to enter the country.

### What should I expect when I arrive?

When you first arrive in the UK you will need to go through immigration and customs control. You'll be asked to present the immigration officer with your valid passport and entry visa, and may be asked to show some documents including evidence of where you will live, an offer of admission and proof that you have money to cover any fees and living expenses you'll have while you're here.

# Money, Insurance & Healthcare

## Intro

When arriving at Edinburgh Napier you will be able to pick up your student status letter at the Student Hub which is located on the Merchiston campus. The letter allows you to show that you are a student and are eligible for student accounts and student benefits. During the first couple of weeks of term there will be banks, insurance companies and doctors surgeries on campus to help you register and ensure that you are getting the right advice for students.

If you're living in rented accommodation, it's also a good idea to consider purchasing contents insurance. While break-ins are rare, it will give you peace of mind in case anything ever happens to any of your valuables.

## Tips and Advice

### How do I open a bank account?

To open a bank account, make an appointment with your bank of choice and bring with you your passport, student ID card, student status letter and proof of address. You will need to show the bank your accommodation acceptance letter if you're living on campus, along with proof of your home address. It's also wise to ask when making the appointment if there are any other documents you require to get an account opened.

### Where can I get insurance?

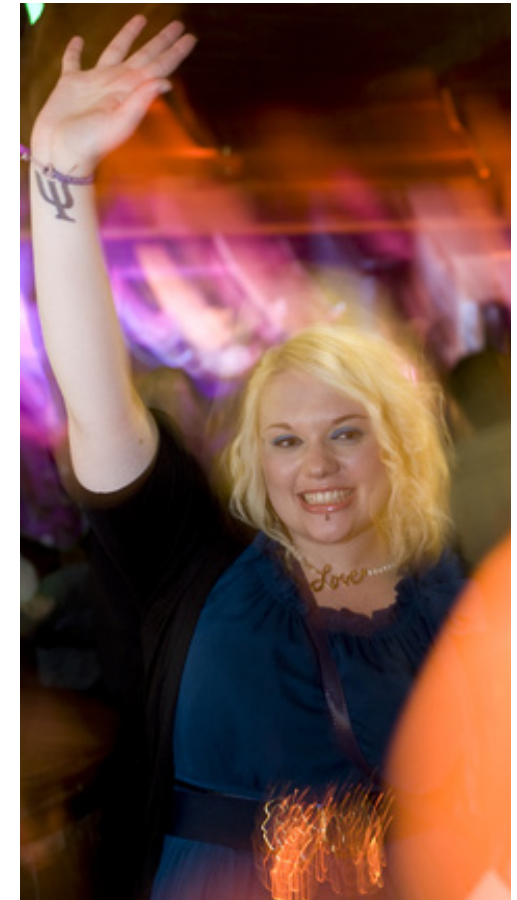
In the UK there are a number of insurance providers that offer everything from contents to travel insurance. Many people choose to take out insurance policies through their bank. You can also find a policy to suit you on a price comparison website, which will help you secure the best deal.

### Do I have access to healthcare?

The National Health Service (NHS) provides professional healthcare to people living in the UK. When you arrive you will need to register with the doctors' surgery in your neighbourhood to gain access. Under the NHS you can visit the doctor for free if you are an international student studying full-time.

### What if I need medication?

If medication is prescribed to you by your GP you will be able to get this free of charge at your local pharmacy.



# Accommodation

## Intro

Your own living space is one of the most exciting aspects of moving away from home for the first time and for many students is an important aspect of University life. There is accommodation available both on and off campus. It is your decision on where you would like to stay.

## University accommodation

University accommodation is provided by Edinburgh Napier and offers shared living space for full-time students. Each flat contains its own kitchen and living area and is equipped with kitchen appliances, laundry facilities and furniture. You have your own private furnished bedroom that includes a wardrobe and desk and all your bills are included in the price of the flat. University accommodation is very social - you'll be surrounded by other Edinburgh Napier students who are sharing many of the same experiences for the first time as you are.

## Private accommodation

If you would prefer not to stay in university accommodation, or are not eligible, private accommodation is a great alternative. You have the option to search for a new flat with other students, live on your own, or live in a flat with a spare room for rent. If you choose to go down this route, sites like Gumtree and Edinburgh Studentpad can help you find flatmates and available accommodation - but make sure you always view the place before agreeing to rent it and never hand over a deposit before you have signed a contract or collected your keys from the landlord or letting agent. The advantage of private accommodation is that you can choose a flat in any neighbourhood you like, and can opt for furnished or unfurnished flats depending on what you're planning to bring with you or buy when you move.



# Keeping in touch

## Staying Connected

Moving away from friends and family is a difficult adjustment for many international students who come to study at Edinburgh Napier.

Staying in touch with loved ones back home - as well as all the new friends you'll make while you're here - doesn't need to be difficult. One of the biggest challenges many of our international students have is the change in time zones and finding the right time to talk, but with a little creativity and some modern methods most manage to keep connected with no trouble at all.

## Tips

The easiest way to stay in touch during a busy semester is with a mobile phone. If you want to keep your phone from back home, you can purchase a SIM card from a local provider or opt to buy a new phone once you arrive. There are many different tariffs that offer everything from international calling to mobile internet and unlimited texts, and almost all will offer a pay as you go service. To keep your bill down, it's also a good idea to invest in a calling card that you can make use of when making long distance calls. Text messaging is another affordable and convenient way to keep in touch on the move.

The internet also helps make it easy - when you arrive at Edinburgh Napier you'll be set up with your own private student email address for course work, which you can also use to keep in touch with your classmates, lecturers, friends and family. Free services like Skype also offer the opportunity to video call loved ones back home for a face-to-face catch up. For most students, social networking also plays a huge part, and makes it easy for you to share all the things you've been up to in Edinburgh with your social circles.



# Edinburgh

## Intro

Edinburgh's social scene is one that's both exciting and diverse. For a small city, it's packed with music venues, restaurants, bars and cinemas - each neighbourhood has its own unique flavour. Whether you're after culture or nightlife, there's plenty of everything in Edinburgh.

The Grassmarket is a centre of nightlife and a popular location for student-friendly

bars and clubs. George Street is also home to the city's cocktail bars and is the choice for many looking for a more sophisticated evening out.

Along Lothian Road in Tollcross you can find much of Edinburgh's entertainment; there is an Odeon cinema, along with the famous Filmhouse and Cameo Cinema, both specialising in classics and independent release films.

## Brief History

Calling Edinburgh a city with history is an understatement - Edinburgh's Castle Rock was first fortified in 900 BC, and has been the longest continually occupied site in Scotland. Because of that, the city benefits from some of the most stunning architecture in Europe, and with its beautiful old buildings, you can trace Edinburgh from its origins in the Old Town as it expanded outwards.

It's a city whose intellectuals made leaps in philosophy, science and medicine during the Enlightenment - a tradition that still stands today. Famous landmarks like Edinburgh Castle, Calton Hill and Holyrood Palace help tell the story of a city that's evolved through time and earned its position as the Scottish capital.

## Museums and galleries

The city of Edinburgh has no shortage of museums and galleries to explore, and most of them are free to visit. Spend an hour or an afternoon learning about everything from Scottish history to modern art.

In the city centre, you can find the National Museum of Scotland, the Scottish National Portrait Gallery, Scottish National Gallery and the Scottish National Gallery of Modern Art, all offering free admission to visitors. Edinburgh also boasts a number of smaller galleries and museums, like the City Art Centre and Writer's Museum.

## Weather

The weather in Edinburgh is predictably unpredictable all year round. Like most of the United Kingdom, the climate is temperate, which means we don't experience huge extremes in temperatures throughout the year. In July and August the average temperature is roughly 19°C, while during the winter months the average temperature is a little over freezing. It's not unusual to get snow during the winter; however it's usually no more than a light covering that melts away after a few days.

Because of the city's northern location, daylight hours vary significantly between summer and winter. On the longest day of the year in June the sun doesn't set until after 10pm, while on the shortest day the sun sets just after 3:30 pm. For many students coming to Edinburgh Napier from warmer climates, adjusting to the lack of sunshine is the most challenging aspect of life in a new city.

## Events

Edinburgh is as famous for its special events as it is for its culture and heritage. Each year, the city's calendar is packed with events, most notably the Edinburgh International Festival and Fringe. Every August, performers from around the world take over the city for a month of entertainment of all kinds.

From food festivals to film festivals, there are always exciting things happening in Edinburgh, culminating with the Hogmanay celebrations on New Year's Eve, where the entire city flocks to an outdoor street party to ring in the New Year.

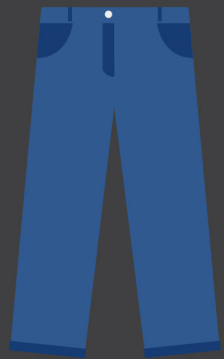

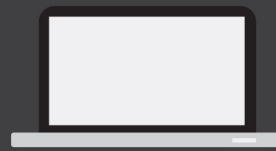
