ADMISSIONS PROCESS

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission is based on your complete academic history and your achievement in three key areas: English Language Proficiency, Five Academic Subjects, and your Academic Average. uab.ca/iapply

FIVE ACADEMIC SUBJECTS

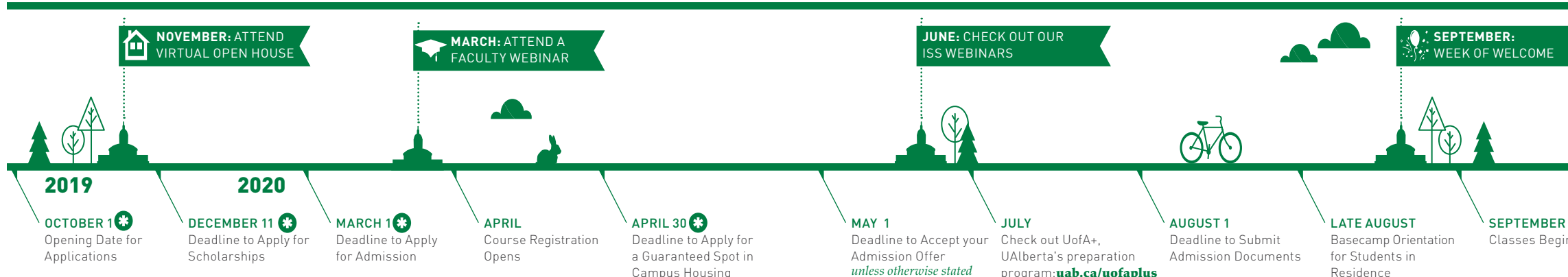
Students from high school must show that they have successfully completed five academic subjects. The subjects you need to present will vary by program choice and faculty. uab.ca/iapply

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

You need to demonstrate English proficiency. uab.ca/engpro

COMPETITIVE AVERAGE

The minimum admission average to be accepted to UAlberta depends on the Faculty and your Program of choice. uab.ca/compreq

- You should attach your year 11 results and confirmation of courses you are taking in your final year
- You will be required to submit a CAD \$125 application fee by credit card.
- You may be required to submit some additional documents (with your application. See: uab.ca/intdocs)

STAY CONNECTED

CHECK YOUR UALBERTA EMAIL

Once you submit your application, you'll be assigned a new UAlberta email address, a unique student number, and a Campus Computing ID (CCID). Going forward, this is the email address we'll use to correspond with you. uab.ca/mail

CHECK YOUR APPLICATION STATUS

After you have submitted your application, you will have access to the UAlberta Launchpad portal to check your application status and review any checklist items for your program.

ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

SECURE YOUR PLACE AT UALBERTA

Once you receive an admission offer, you'll need to accept your offer and pay your tuition deposit by the deadline stated in the UAlberta Launchpad portal.

Watch your email for your admission offer and for instructions on how to accept.

PREPARE TO COME TO CANADA

OBTAIN YOUR STUDY PERMIT

In order to study in Canada, you will need a study permit. Application processing time can take three months or more. We encourage you to apply for your study permit well in advance of your program start date. You can use your Letter of Admission to start your study permit application. For complete information on immigration and application requirements, consult the Government of Canada website at www.cic.gc.ca

OTHER TO-DOS

SUBMIT YOUR DOCUMENTS

Check your To-Do List in the UAlberta Launchpad portal to see what outstanding documents and other items are still required, and ensure they are submitted by the deadline indicated.

To retain your admission offer, ensure all required documents are submitted by the deadline and meet the conditions specified in your offer. Documents must be sent to UAlberta's Registrar's Office directly from the authorized issuing institution by the posted deadlines.

Remember to include your UAlberta 7-digit ID number with all documents.

INDIA ADMISSIONS INFORMATION

Students may enter the University of Alberta using Class XII CBSE or CISCE national board, or state-issued board results. To be considered for a conditional offer from a national board, students will need to submit their Class X board results and Class XII school predicted grades showing a competitive average.

To be considered for a conditional offer from a state board, students will need their school results for Class XI showing a competitive average and course registration for Class XII, or Class XII mid-year results.

The offer would become unconditional upon receipt of the final Class XII board exam results meeting the University of Alberta's requirements.

Students who present 75% or higher in their CBSE or CISCE Class XII exams will meet English proficiency requirements; students taking state board must present a minimum score in one of the accepted standardized tests listed on the UAlberta website. The minimum requirements for IELTS is 6.5 with no band less than 5.5. For more information visit: uab.ca/engpro

UAlberta also accepts students from a variety of international curricula including A levels, IB, American, and AP.

AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS



AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

UAlberta provides millions of dollars in awards and scholarships to international students every year. If you achieve a UAlberta admission average of 90% or higher, you will automatically be considered for at least \$9,000 CAD and top students can receive even more! uab.ca/intawards

ADMISSION-BASED AWARDS

You could be starting with a scholarship you didn't even have to apply for! Your eligibility is based on your admission average at the time of your admission offer.

Gold Standard Scholarship

The top 5% of students in each faculty could receive up to \$6,000, depending on admission average.

International Student Scholarship

Students with superior academics in high school may receive a scholarship up to \$9,000, payable over four years.

International Country Scholarship

Top students from UAlberta targeted regions could receive \$5,000.

APPLICATION-BASED AWARDS

There's no need to figure out what you might be eligible for, just fill out one application and UAlberta will assess you based on your background, experiences, academics, and interests.

University of Alberta Centenary Scholarship

Students with exceptional academic achievement may be eligible for up to \$20,000 over four years.

International Entrance Leadership Scholarship

Well-rounded leaders with superior academics may receive up to \$5,000.

You must apply early to your program, so you can apply for awards — the application-based awards deadline is December 11, 2019.

FEES EXPLAINED

GUARANTEED TUITION

YOUR UALBERTA TUITION WILL NOT INCREASE.

As an international student at UAlberta you will know the total tuition for your program when you receive admission.

CERTAINTY AND CLARITY

- In order to help you plan for the financial requirements of attending university, UAlberta provides you with a tuition guarantee for the total tuition cost of your program.
- Your program will be assessed equally across four years, the total cost can be paid in four annual or eight semi-annual installments.
- Read the full details of the guarantee at uab.ca/guarantee

TUITION GUARANTEE DETAILS

- Your tuition guarantee only applies to the standard requirements, including electives, necessary to complete your program. It does not include any mandatory non-instructional fees or other costs such as the U-Pass, textbooks, residence fees, students associations, etc. It also does not include the cost for any courses you choose to take as extra or that need to be repeated due to withdrawal or failure.
- If you choose to take Spring/Summer courses, your total program tuition will remain the same however your annual total will increase for that year.
- Your tuition guarantee is set for the typical duration of your program plus one year. Typically programs are four years, therefore the guarantee would be in place for five years.
- Should you require a fifth year of study to complete your program requirements, you will not face additional tuition costs in that fifth year. If your remaining courses exceed your program requirements, you will pay per course. In either case, payment for mandatory non-instructional fees in the fifth year will be required. If you have outstanding program requirements to complete after five years you will be required to pay for those remaining courses, individually, at the current rate in that academic year.
- If you change programs at UAlberta your original guarantee will no longer be valid, and you will receive a new guarantee for your new program.
- In the event of a discrepancy between the tuition amounts displayed in this publication and your University of Alberta Offer of Admission, the Offer of Admission shall be taken as correct.

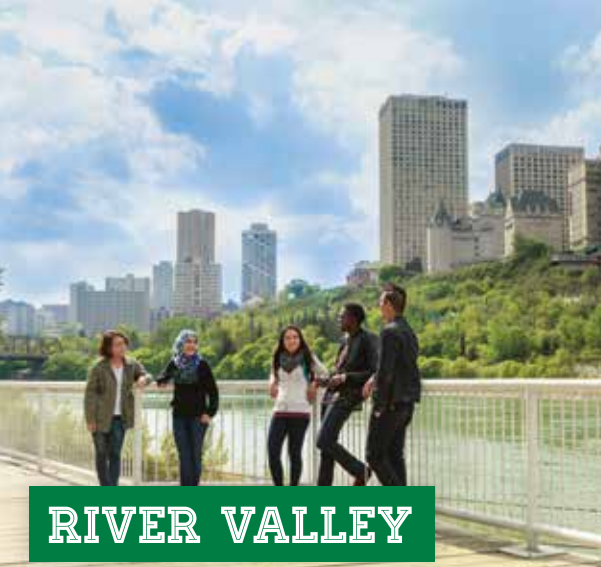
LIVE IN RESIDENCE
